



## **Banyan Terminal changing the Jurong Island landscape**

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Banyan Terminal is fast becoming a prominent landscape in the Banyan sector of Jurong Island. It is difficult to miss the spectacular sight of our 26 petroleum & chemical tanks, totaling 371,200 cbm, which are taking up shape progressively over the past few months.

Overall progress for the tankage facility is looking good. Hydrostatic test for some of the tanks has completed and painting of these tanks has started. Civil works for the loading pump station for the petroleum tanks are almost completed. Headers which are pre-fabricated, have been delivered to the site. Other major equipments like loading pumps and loading arms are also delivered to the shop / site. Casting activity for the main office building is completed as well.

On the jetty, all the 132 piles have been driven. Construction of the approach trestle and pipe-rack columns has completed. The jetty contractor, McConnell Dowel is focusing on the main platform construction of the 120,000 / 80,000 dwt finger pier jetty, which is expected to complete by end October 2005.

As of September 2005, tankage and jetty construction's Zero LTI/TIR has accumulated 669,488 manhours and 106,511 manhours respectively.

The overall Banyan Project is well on schedule for completion by 1st April 2006.
