



Vopak Asia 2005 SHE Performance

For 2005, Vopak Asia recorded an LTIR of 1.2 and TIR of 5.3 for employees. Our safety targets were met for both employees and contractors. We also achieved an overall reduction in incident frequency over 2004.

In our continuous effort to create a safer workplace for all, we've set even higher targets for the region for 2006 – Zero. To achieve this milestone requires full commitment not only from top down but also bottom up. Every level of employee has an active and critical role to play in ensuring and protecting a safe workplace. These are characteristics of the industry's best-in-class companies which we aspire to be one.

In line with this, there have been recent global developments aimed at further enhancing operational excellence within Vopak. They are as follow:

- Development and implementation of Vopak Operational Excellence minimum standards;
- Implementation of Project Management Procedures;
- Vopak Safety Fundamentals self-assessment tool.

2006 will also be a year where the Terminal Health Assessment (THA) will be in full swing with 6 audits planned for Asia – Sydney, Kertih, Penjuru, Engro, VSL and VNPTT. Together with our very own regional SHE initiatives, 2006 will again be a very busy year for all of us.
