



## Work in Progress at Vopak Australia

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### Darwin

Since the September 2005 commissioning date, 95 million liters of product has been lifted from the terminal covering the mining, military and public sector markets. To date, no significant problems have been identified with the terminal operation. The co-mingled customers have indicated that 750 million litres of product will be handled for the full year 2006.

### Sydney Site B

Construction has commenced on the additional 74,400 cbm of tank storage at site B due to demand from the fuel industry for third party terminal space. The additional tankage is an expansion of the existing site B terminal located at Port Botany and would expect to be commissioned in late 2006. The expansion programme is supported by two major oil companies with the intent to co-mingle products. Products handled will be jet fuel and ground fuels.

Two 17,500 cbm tanks have been converted from ground fuel use in the existing B1 terminal to accommodate a new major jet fuel customer. Modification to existing pipe-work as well as the installation of a new pumping system was required to enable this business to be secured. The first transfer of 10,000 cbm was completed in early Jan 2006 with no problems.



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
