



## Construction Projects in Thailand

On 31<sup>st</sup> of December 2005, mechanical completion of the final project for 2005 was realized. In total, 6 tanks were added, which are needed to handle the increased throughput of the terminal.

With the project's completion, the 14 years-old Thai Tank Terminal saw a total of US\$14 million of new investments taking place in 2005. Besides the expansion of the tank facilities, this amount also includes projects such as a third jetty.

The completion also means that there is room for only another 7 tanks with a capacity of 32,000 cbm within the existing battery limits of the TTT facility, now comprising of 83 tanks with a total capacity of 632,400 cbm. Expansion is therefore high on the agenda for the coming period.

A noteworthy item is the fact that all projects were completed within budget and within the target completion date. More importantly, TTT achieved this without an LTI or serious injury from both TTT or contractors employees.
