

## Penjuru Terminal Plans Expansion

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Located in Jurong, West of Singapore, the Penjuru terminal occupies 22 hectares of land and operates mainly as a third party distribution terminal. Currently, it has a total storage capacity of 150,950 cbm in 149 tanks in the range of 500 to 5,000 cbm.

With the outlook of a buoyant storage market in the next few years, particularly attributed to the surging crude prices and strong chemical import flows into Asia, Vopak Terminals Singapore (VTS) is ready to embark on another facet of its growth in Singapore. With ample available land and jetty space, VTS is ready to add another 22,000 cbm in Penjuru, bringing the total capacity to 172,950 cbm by Q3 2008. The expansion consists of two tank pits with 12 carbon steel tanks on an existing 1 hectare of vacant land. Additional dock lines and a truck loading rack will be constructed in order to service the additional throughputs. Drumming services can be provided at a nearby drumming shed. Construction is planned to commence in Q2 2007.

Beyond 2008, the terminal has the potential to expand by another 80,000 to 100,000 cbm of tank storage space. Strategically, this will further reinforce Penjuru's role as distribution and transshipment hub for the growing pool of chemical traders and distributors in Singapore.
