

APPV Vopak Signs Construction Contract

On the 5th of April 2007, APPV Vopak Management signed a contract with MEI Engineering for the detailed design and construction of 40,000 m³ of carbon steel storage. MEI Engineering was the successful bidder from an original 11 selected construction companies.

The construction schedule will take 12 months and completion and commissioning is expected in March 2008. Facilities will include an upgrade of the jetty, construction of 28 tanks in 3 tank pits, 12 jetty lines, 6 truck loading bays, an additional 3 drum filling systems and water treatment plant.

In addition, the N₂ and fire systems and electrical equipment will be upgraded. The terminal will be fully automated and a CCR will be located in the main office block by modifying the east end lower level to accommodate the automation control equipment.
