

Our Expansion Around Asia

Penjuru / Singapore

The 4th of April 2007, marked a major milestone in Vopak Penjuru Terminal's future as the contract signing for the expansion project was concluded at the PSA building. The expansion project comprises of 12 new carbon steel tanks on an existing 1-hectare of land and is expected to complete within 13 months. The project includes the construction of a new truck rack, a new hose transfer pit and new jetty lines. The project will increase Penjuru Terminal's total capacity to 172,950 cbm. With this increase in storage capacity, Penjuru Terminal will be better positioned to service the strong storage demand in Singapore and the region over the next few years.

Thai Tank Terminal / Thailand

Thai Tank Terminal (TTT)'s ambition to be more active in the spot market required TTT to obtain an additional land of 15 Rai (2.4 hectares). This so-called Phase 3 of our terminal consists of ten tanks, all carbon steel. The construction started by the end of August 2006 and the tanks should be operational by September 1st 2007. Although this timing is challenging TTT is confident that by September 1st 2007 our capacity will increase from 632,000 up to 686,000 cbm.

AP Petrochemicals Vietnam / Vietnam

Site preparation at our AP Petrochemicals Vietnam terminal commenced in early June 2007 with the construction of a fence to segregate the construction site from the operational area, plus the construction of a temporary gate and road into the construction area. Civil works including the piling will go into full swing during week commencing 25th June 2007. The 28-tanks project is scheduled to be completed in April 2008 when commissioning of the facilities will take place. Detailed design commenced in March 2007 and will be completed shortly.
